Coweta County School System Closures Extended Until April 13

The Coweta County School System has extended the current school closure until Monday, April 13. The school system will continue to evaluate the situation throughout this time, and will remain in contact with state and local officials regarding the ongoing COVID-19 health event. During this period, the school system may receive additional guidance from state officials that extends school closures beyond April 13. This information will be provided to parents and employees as it becomes available.

This extended school closure includes the school system's scheduled Spring Break period of April 6 through 10. Distance Learning during the school closure will continue through Friday, April 3. Spring Break will continue as an off-week for students and staff. If an extension of the current school closure is necessary, Distance Learning for students would resume on Monday, April 13.

As with the school system's initial closure period, Frequently Asked Question documents regarding this extended school closure are being prepared. A new FAQ will be provided for students and parents by Monday, March 30. The system will also provide a new FAQ for employees by Monday, March 30.

As before this extension, all previously scheduled school activities, including extracurricular activities, sports, practices and trips, are cancelled until further notice. Principals and teachers will communicate with students regarding digital learning activities for students. Parents who have a question about a student should contact their child's principal through email for assistance.

The school district will communicate with employees in the event of any changes regarding their work-related duties during this time period.

The school system will remain in consultation with the Georgia Governor's office, the Georgia Department of Education, the Georgia Department of Public Health and other state and local authorities as school officials evaluate this evolving situation. The school system asks that staff and families continue to follow the COVID-19 guidelines as shared by the [Georgia Department of Public Health](#) and the [Centers for Disease Control](#).
