Dear Parent/Guardian,

Each Coweta County school, in coordination with the Curriculum Department and Special Education Services and Supports Department, will provide adapted/supplemental materials on an individual basis that will allow parental access to content that they may choose to use with their children during school closure. Please be aware that there is **no requirement** that students complete these activities. Completion is at the discretion of the parent and these assignments/activities will not be used for grading purposes.

Special Education Teachers and Service Providers (Speech, OT/PT) will be providing the following supports for students/parents:

1. Reminders (through email, phone call, or by whatever platform the student's school is using to disseminate work) about literacy tools like Read and Write for Google available to assist them in the completion of optional activities provided by the base school.
2. As appropriate, adapted assignments that correlate to the items provided by their general education teacher(s) by the same method their general education counterpart is using (Google Classroom, etc).
3. Teacher and casemanager district email addresses and a one hour daily window of time that the teacher will respond to any questions you may have regarding the optional assignments provided to your child.
4. Communication regarding previously scheduled IEP meetings, Eligibility meetings, or any other prescheduled conference to let you know that those will be rescheduled once we return to school.
5. **DUE DATES WILL BE EXTENDED - IEP MEETINGS, ELIGIBILITY MEETINGS, OR ANY OTHER MEETING BY PHONE OR OTHER MEANS WILL NOT OCCUR DURING THIS TIME.**

Individual student needs will be taken into consideration in all scenarios. Following an extended school closure, such as the one we are currently in, students will be monitored for regression and recoupment on their IEP program goals.
